Cases at St. Vincent's Hospital ranged from finger replants to free flaps for complex sarcoma reconstructions to breast reconstructions to simple carpal tunnel decompressions.

I attended ward rounds every day, a range of clinics, MDT and audit meetings as well as spending much time in theatres. I was frequently able to act as first assistant in theatres and towards the end of my placement I was allowed to perform parts of procedures supervised.

I learnt to manage free flaps on the ward, harvest FTSGs myself and apply backslabs. I improved my confidence performing much suturing and learnt to close both deep and superficial wounds using a variety of techniques.

At the final departmental audit, I presented a case and literature review on the use of medial femoral condyle vascularised bone graft flaps to treat scaphoid non-union.

## What were the best things about the visit? (120 words max)

The practical experience in a developed world healthcare system was invaluable. Having an extended period of time to dedicate to plastic & reconstructive surgery meant I was fully immersed within the team and was given opportunities I might not otherwise have had.

The 'hands-on' experience was a highlight of my visit as well as the chance to follow up patients in clinic a month after their surgery and see their progress. In contrast to my other elective placement I was taught about and saw surgical techniques at the forefront of modern plastic & reconstructive surgery, for example, the use of synthetic biodegradable temporizing matrix as a dermal scaffold.
