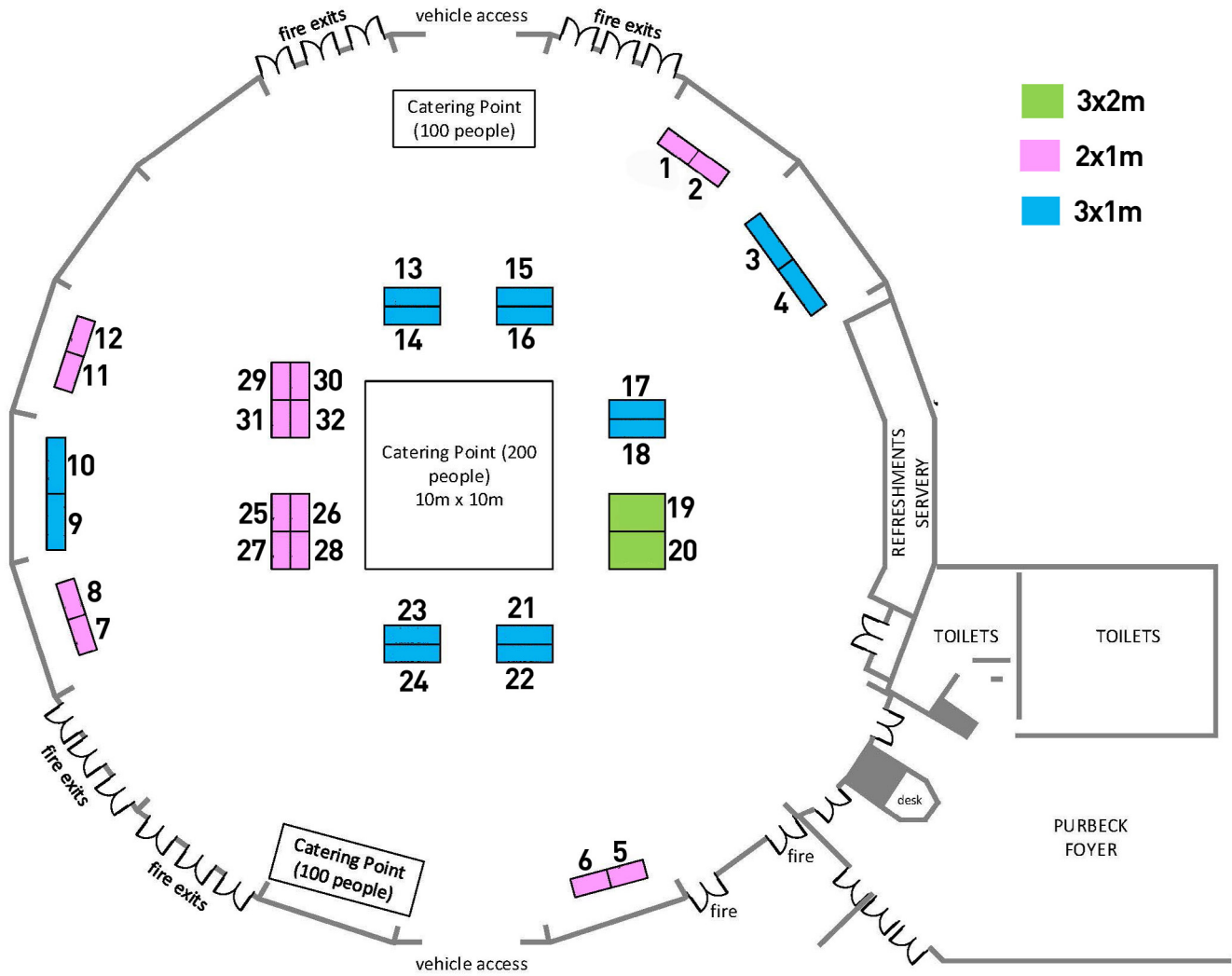
Stand space selection
