19 out of 32 candidates were granted eligibility to proceed to Section 2 (59%)

Type 2 Trainees (3b-2015 Regs) – 0 presented

Not in Training (O-2015 Regs) – 4 out of 6 passed (67%) Candidate

Feedback response rate: 38%

Reliability: 0.86
